Subject: Publication of Educational Events

Review Responsibility: Director of Social Media

Policy Statement:

SGNA will publish notices of selected approved gastroenterology and/or endoscopy related nursing continuing educational offerings as an information service to members.

Focus:

SGNA Members, providers of gastroenterology and/or endoscopy related educational activities.

Purpose:

To define the circumstances in which approved gastroenterology and/or endoscopy related nursing continuing educational activities will be publicized on the website, in *eScope* or in Dates and Deadlines.

Procedure:

- Persons desiring to announce approved gastroenterology and/or endoscopy related nursing continuing educational offerings on the SGNA website must submit a request to SGNA Headquarters.
 - 1.1. To be considered, activities must be applicable to recertification according to the criteria of the American Board of Certification for Gastroenterology Nurses (ABCGN).
 - 1.2. Requests must include identification of the Provider's accreditation body or evidence that the activity is approved by a qualified approver.
- 2. Information must be received in a timely manner that assures SGNA members will receive the notice prior to the date of the event.
- 3. The request will include:
 - 3.1. Title of offering
 - 3.2. Date and time
 - 3.3. Location
 - 3.4. Provider
 - 3.5. Contact person and phone number
- 4. Requests will be considered in the following priority:
 - 4.1. Activities for which SGNA is the Provider (e.g., the Annual Course).
 - 4.2. Activities for which an SGNA Regional Society is the Provider.
 - 4.3. Activities approved by SGNA's Continuing Education Peer Review Group (CEPRG), regardless of the Provider.
- 5. For requests that do not provide continuing education, SGNA will consider promoting to members if the following criteria is met:
 - 5.1. Event is related to the GI/endoscopy industry

- 5.2. The event is being provided by a credible organization5.3. The event does not conflict with any SGNA national events
