Subject: SGNA Associates/Advanced Associates Scholarship

Review Responsibility: SGNA Awards Committee

Policy Statement:

The SGNA Associates and Advanced Associates Program Scholarships have been established to financially assist SGNA associate/technician members and non-members with purchasing the Associates/Advanced Associates Program.

Focus: Member and Non-member Associates and Technicians

Purpose:

To outline the process for application and selection of recipients for SGNA Associates/ Advanced Associates Program Scholarships.

Procedure:

Eligibility for the SGNA Associates/Advanced Associate Program Scholarships will adhere to the following criteria:

- 1.1. Applicant must be an associate or technician.
- 1.2. Applicant must be an SGNA member in good standing for two or more years or a non-member that has been employed in the GI/endoscopy field for at least 3 years.
- 1.3. Must currently be employed as a caregiver in gastroenterology.
- 1.4. Applicant must actively support the goals and philosophy of SGNA.
- 2. Ineligibility for SGNA Associates/Advanced Associates Scholarships include:
 - National Board member
 - If applicant is a Registered Nurse
 - Previous recipient of SGNA Associates/Advanced Associates Scholarship
- 3. Scholarships to be awarded will be determined by:
 - 3.1. The amount of funds available.
 - 3.2. The number of scholarships awarded will be determined by the SGNA Budget, Finance and Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors
- 4. Awards Committee will review all applications and will announce the winners in the form of an Information Report to SGNA Board of Directors.
 - 4.1. Applications will be received at SGNA Headquarters by one of the following quarterly deadlines: March 1, June 1, September 1, December 1 and will be forwarded to the Awards Committee.
 - 4.2. The Awards Committee will review and score all applications and determine winners.
 - 4.3. The Awards Committee will determine the number of individual scholarships, but this will be based on approved funds. Recipients of SGNA scholarships shall be notified by the SGNA Awards Committee.
