Subject: Flame Award for Unit Excellence

Review Responsibility: SGNA Awards Committee

Policy Statement:

The Flame Award for Unit Excellence has been established to recognize GI/Endoscopy Units who have shown a commitment to infection prevention, a supportive and educational work environment and positive patient outcomes. This award provides a roadmap for what is considered an exceptional work environment in a GI/Endoscopy nursing unit.

Focus: Member and Non-member Associates and Technicians

Purpose:

To outline the process for application and selection for the Flame Award for Unit Excellence.

Procedure:

- 1. Eligibility for the Flame Award for Unit Excellence will adhere to the following criteria:
 - 1.1 30% of nurses/technicians have completed the Associates Program
 - 1.2 20% of nurses/technicians have completed the Advanced Associates Program
 - 1.3 30% of eligible nurses have current CGRN status
- 2. Scholarships to be awarded will be determined by:
 - 2.1 The amount of funds available.
 - 2.2 The number of scholarships awarded will be determined by the SGNA Budget, Finance and Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors
- 3. Awards Committee will review all applications and will announce the winners in the form of an Information Report to SGNA Board of Directors.
 - 3.1 Applications will be received at SGNA Headquarters by February 15.
 - 3.2 The Awards Committee will review and score all applications and determine winners.
 - 3.3 The Awards Committee will determine the number of individual scholarships, but this will be based on approved funds. Recipients of SGNA scholarships shall be notified by the SGNA Awards Committee.
- 4. Recipients of the Flame Award will receive a framed certificate, recognition at the Annual Course, and honorable mention in SGNA News and eScope.
