Subject: Medical Aid Scholarship

Review Responsibility: SGNA Awards Committee

Policy Statement:

The Medical Aid Scholarship was established to financially assist SGNA members who are participating in a medical aid trip.

Focus: SGNA Members

Purpose:

To outline the process for application and selection for recipients of the Medical Aid Scholarship.

Procedure:

- Applicants for the Medical Aid Scholarship will adhere to the following criteria:
 - 1.1 SGNA Member in good standing
 - 1.2 Must meet criteria of the organization through which they are traveling
 - 1.3 Medical aid trip must be through an established organization and not independently planned
 - 1.4 Must be receiving scholarship for the first time.
- 2. Scholarships to be awarded will be determined by:
 - 2.1 The amount of funds available.
 - 2.2 The number of scholarships awarded will be determined by the SGNA Budget, Finance and Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors
- 3. Awards Committee will review all applications and will announce the winners in the form of an Information Report to SGNA Board of Directors.
 - 3.1 Applications will be received at SGNA Headquarters by December 31.
 - 3.2 The Awards Committee will review and score all applications and determine winners.
 - 3.3 The Awards Committee will determine the number of individual scholarships, but this will be based on approved funds. Recipients of SGNA scholarships shall be notified by the SGNA Awards Committee.
- 4. Recipients of the Medical Aid Scholarship will receive funds of \$1000 up front and must be used within the calendar year in which they were awarded. Proof of participation in a program must be established before funds are issued. Recipients of the scholarship will be asked to write an article about their experience for the SGNA News.
