## **Policy Statement:**

SGNA's Board of Directors Award provides SGNA with a mechanism to honor individuals who have contributed to the society.

## Focus:

Board of Directors

## Purpose:

To recognize an individual whose outstanding contributions have affected the image of SGNA and the practice of its members. This award is not intended to be awarded every year.

## Procedure:

- 1. Eligibility: Candidates, are not limited to members, may be from any field (nursing, education, politics, management, business, etc.).
- 2. Criteria:
  - 2.1 Supports and promotes SGNA's mission and goals on both national and regional levels.
  - 2.2 Promotes both members' and public awareness of SGNA and gastroenterology nursing
- 3. Nominations: may be made by any member of the Board of Directors.
- 4. Process:
  - 4.1 Awards Committee Board Liaison makes call for nominations.
  - 4.2 Nominations to be submitted in 500 words or less why you believe this individual should be considered for the award.
  - 4.2 Submit nomination to Awards Committee Board Liaison by January 1 of each year.
  - 4.3 Awards Committee Board Liaison submits Action Report to Board for Winter Board Meeting review and approval.
  - 4.4 Selection of the winning recipient passed on to Headquarters to carry out fulfillment of award.
- 5. Award: the recipient receives a specially commissioned award, five (5) tickets to the awards banquet and will be a guest of honor.
