Review Responsibility: House of Delegates Speaker and Vice Speaker

Policy Statement:

Standing Rules are opened for debate and adopted by the delegates at the 1st House of Delegates meeting to provide rules to follow for meetings.

Focus:

Regional Delegates/Alternates, House Speaker and Vice-Speaker of the House.

Purpose:

To provide clarification in using the Standing Rules during House of Delegates formal meetings.

Supportive Data:

Standing Rules supersede Robert's Rules of Order for the conduct of business at the House of Delegates formal meetings.

Procedure:

- 1. Each year the Speaker and Vice-Speaker review the Standing Rules.
- 2. A copy of the Standing Rules is distributed prior to the House of Delegates sessions to each delegate and alternate.
- 3. At the 1st House of Delegates session the Standing Rules are opened for debate and adopted.
- 4. Standing Rules supersede Robert's Rules of Order.
