**Subject**: House of Delegates Reference Hearings/Reference Committees **Review Responsibility**: House of Delegates Speaker

## **Policy Statement:**

Resolutions submitted to the House of Delegates are openly debated prior to vote.

## Focus:

Regional Delegates/Alternates, Speaker of the House and Vice-Speaker of the House.

## **Purpose:**

To establish a protocol for the debate of resolutions at the House of Delegates.

## **Procedure:**

- 1. Reference Hearings are informal sessions open to all SGNA members for discussion of the resolutions before the House of Delegates.
- 2. Reference Committees are established by the Vice-Speaker of the House.
  - 2.1 The number of Reference Committees will be at the discretion of the Vice-Speaker and Speaker of the House.
- 3. A Reference Committee member must be a regional delegate.
- 4. Reference Committees are composed of, but not limited to, Chair, Recorder and Timer.
- 5. The Chair presents the resolutions and opens debate.
- 6. The Timer monitors the time to ensure each resolution is given equal time in which members can voice their concerns.
  - 6.1 Debate on each resolution shall be limited to 10 minutes.
  - 6.2 Additional time may be requested with a motion from the floor.
  - 6.3 Debate is limited to 2 minutes per individual.
  - 6.4 An individual may have additional time to speak, once everyone else has spoken.
- 7. The Recorder(s) make notations regarding the general consensus of those speaking and whether they are speaking for or against the resolutions.
  - 7.1 These notations are maintained to guide the Reference Committee to recommend adoption or rejection for each resolution.
- 8. The Reference Committee responsibilities include:
  - 8.1 Present the proposed resolutions.

- 8.2 Facilitate discussion of the issues.
- 8.3 Summarize the debate discussion to reflect the majority opinion.
- 8.4 Make recommendations based on the majority opinion for immediate vote following the close of debate on each resolution.
- 9. Reference Committee responsibilities are limited to the House of Delegates to which they have been appointed Committee membership.
  - 9.1 The committee composition is determined annually.
