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Subject: Dissolution of Special Interest Groups (E-SIGs)

Review Responsibility: Director of Social Media

Policy Statement:

The SGNA Board of Directors may dissolve an e-SIG when it does not meet the needs of, or fails to fulfill its responsibility to its members.

Purpose:

To establish a procedure for dissolution of e-SIGs

Focus:

SGNA Board of Directors, Director of Social Media and SGNA Headquarters

Supportive Data:

e-SIGs are comprised of members who share a common interest in a sub-specialty in Gastroenterology and/or endoscopy nursing. On occasion it may become appropriate to dissolve one of these special interest groups.

Procedure:

- 1. An e-SIG may be dissolved for any or all of the following reasons:
 - 1.1 Current e-SIG members have determined that the need for such a group no longer exists;
 - 1.2 Changes in the strategic plan of the parent organization or the needs of the membership that make this group obsolete.
 - 1.3 Lack of interest for continuing this group.
- 2. Immediately upon occurrence, the Director of Social Media will report to the Board any e-SIG having significant organizational issues, or failing to meet any of the above outlined requirements.
- 3. The SGNA Board of Directors will determine the outcome of the e-SIG.
 - 3.1 A probationary period may be granted.
- 4. Specific e-SIG dissolution is official as directed by the SGNA Board of Directors. Dissolution will be December 31 of the current year.
- 5. Notification of members will occur in the *SGNA News, eScope* and on the SGNA e-SIG website.
