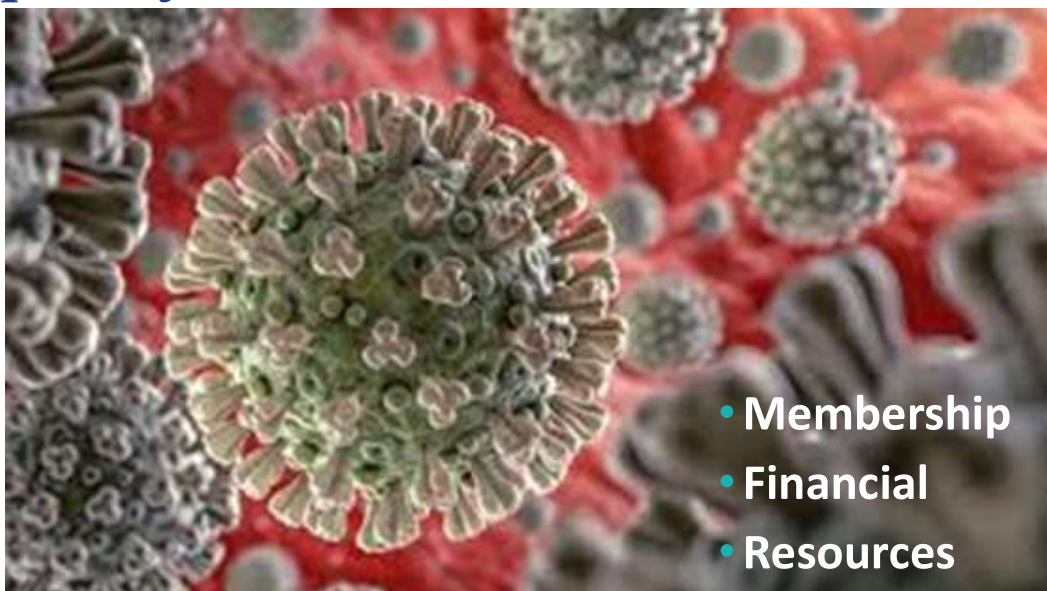

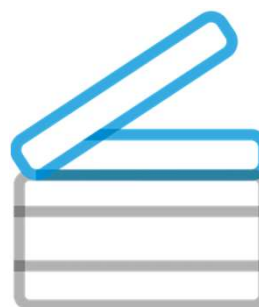
- Customize confirmation emails to provide all relevant info to attendees

- Create planned polls in advance

- Collect questions throughout to answer in Q&A session or in post session follow-up

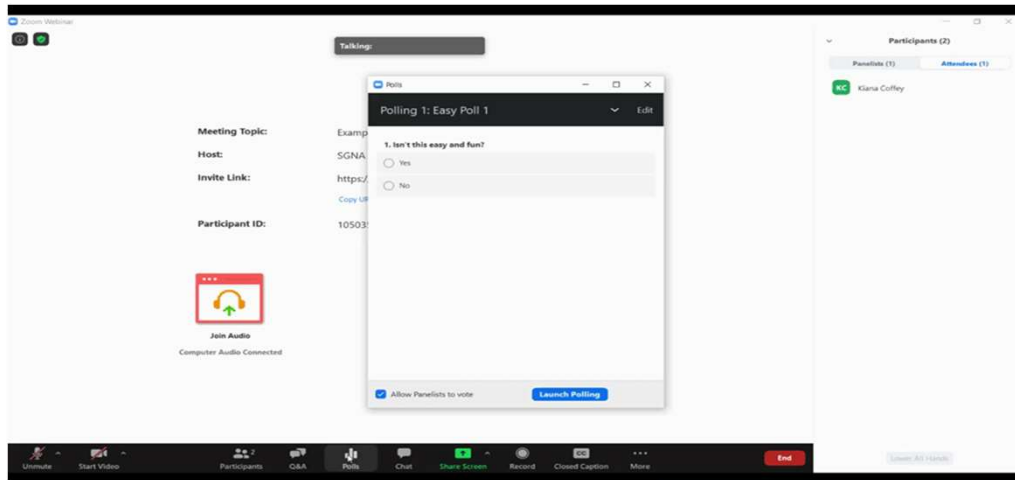

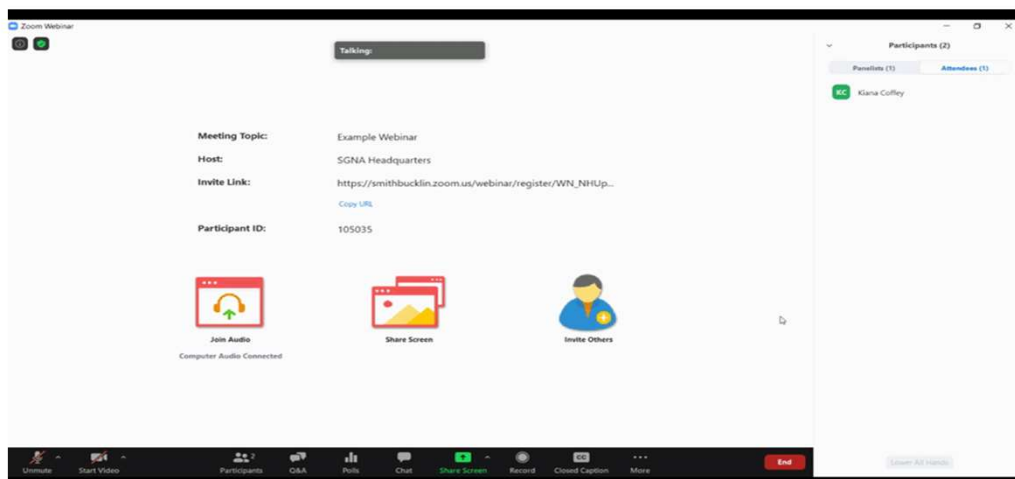

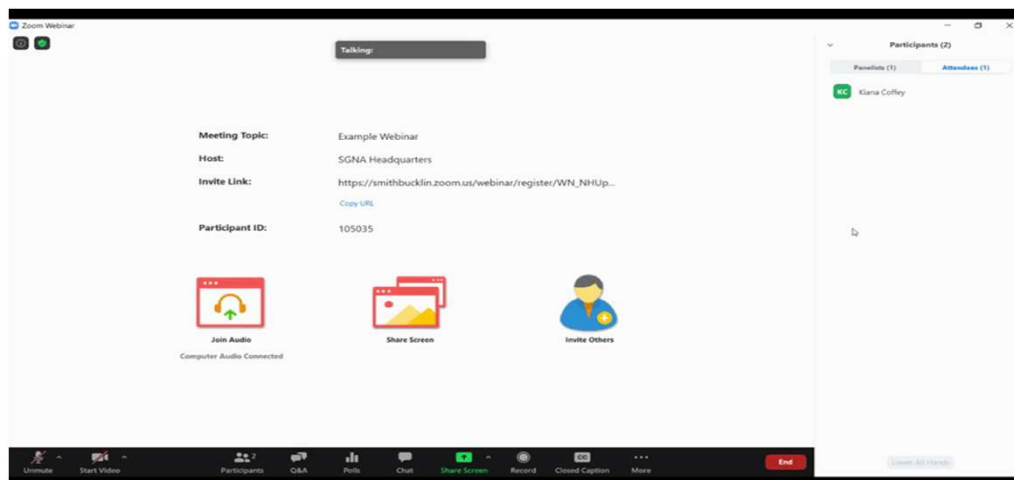

Reports and Surveys

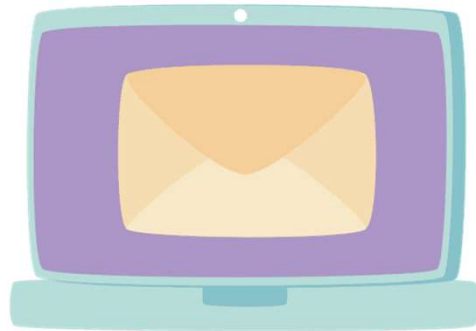
- Zoom generates reports for registration, attendance, performance, Q&A, polls
