

GABRIELE SCHINDLER EXCELLENCE AWARD \$5.000

Named for an early pioneer in gastroenterology patient care, the Gabriele Schindler Award annually recognizes a member who has made important contributions in direct patient care in one or more performance categories. This prestigious award includes an inscribed plaque and medallion, full course registration, airfare and three-night hotel stay at the Annual Course, at which the video presentation is made. Recipient will be recognized on the SGNA website and in the *Inside Tract*. ASSOCIATES PROGRAM \$25,000 / Program Sponsorship
