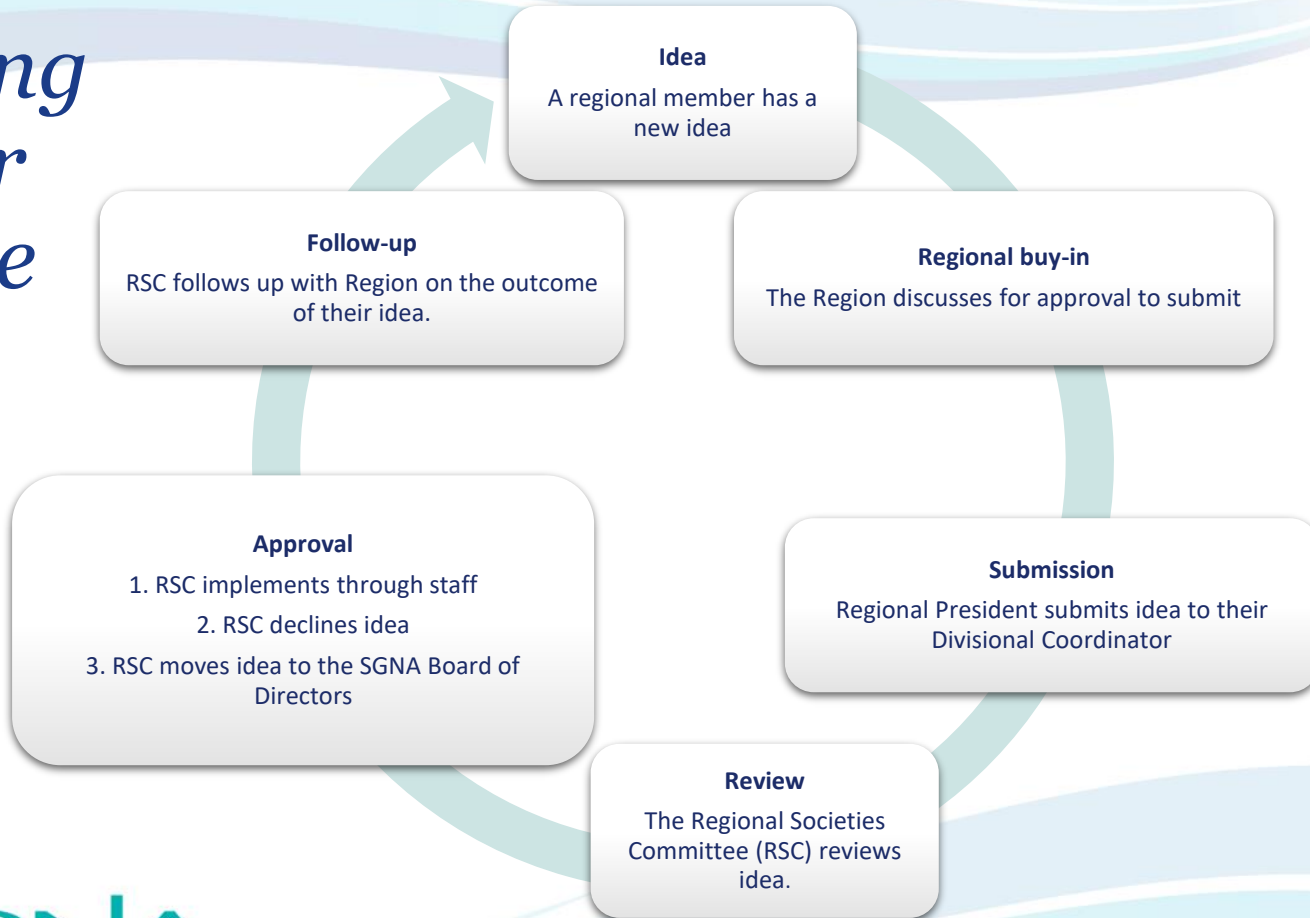


Results of the Bylaw Vote

- Total votes cast: 402 – about 8% of the membership
 - Approval = 391
 - Reject = 11
- Results shared with membership on May 17.

- How can regions support state legislation on this act in the states where it hasn't been passed yet?

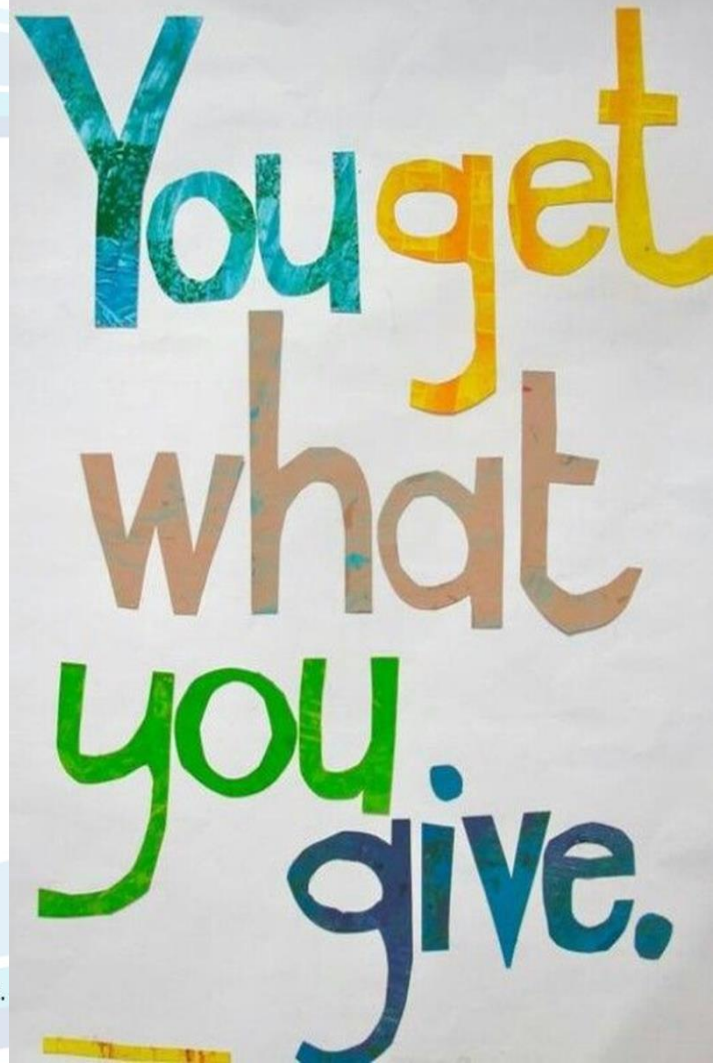

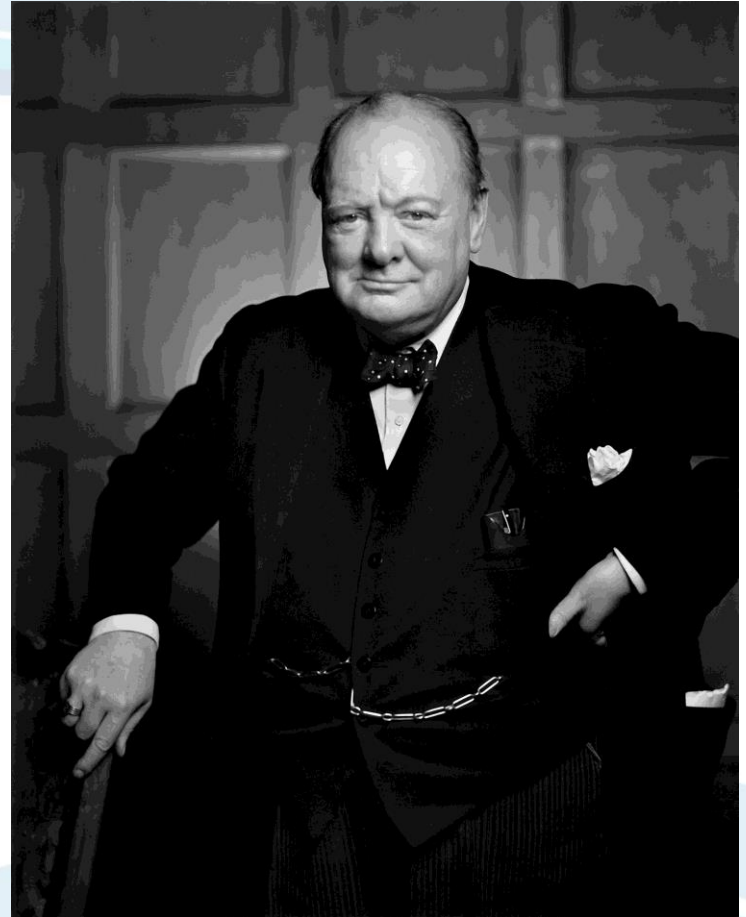

Extrinsic Influences

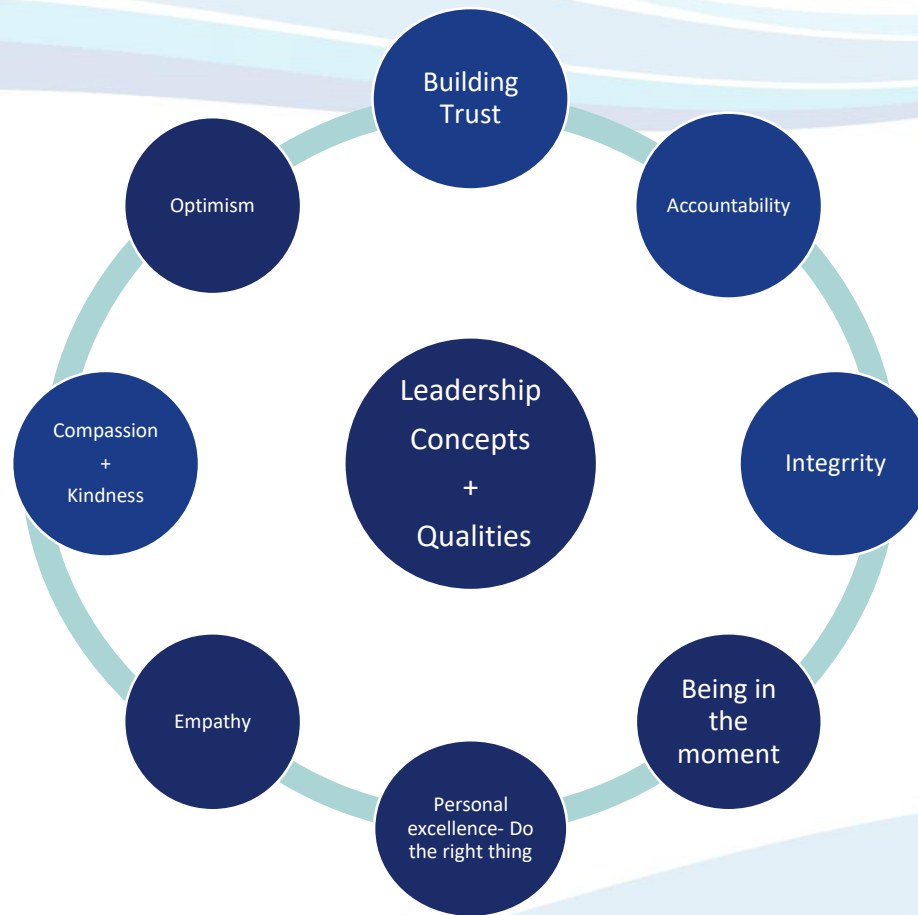
- Money
